IMYC Year 7 - 9

The International Middle Years Curriculum (IMYC), is specifically designed to support the academic and personal development of teenagers. It is based on research into the critical needs of the adolescent brain, ensuring that students receive the right balance of challenge and support at this crucial stage.

The IMYC is rigorous, internationally minded, and concept-focused. It encourages students to become engaged, active learners by developing their knowledge, skills, and understanding in a structured and meaningful way. The curriculum framework provides a clear pathway for learning while making subject areas more interconnected.

The IMYC is taught through thematic units, which link learning across different subjects in a practical and exciting way. This approach not only enhances subject mastery but also strengthens critical thinking and real-world application. By providing a strong academic foundation, the IMYC prepares students for their next stages of education, including IGCSE and A-levels. Currently, it is used in 50 countries worldwide, demonstrating its effectiveness in fostering holistic, globally aware learners.

IGCSE Year 10 - 11

After careful research, we chose to offer the International certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) for students in the years 10 and 11. The IGCSE is a widely recognized and internationally respected qualification. It is familiar to many of our parents and has been tried and tested for academic excellence.

The IGCSE program allows students to select a broad range of subjects tailored to their individual strengths and interests. It is a two year course, concluding with internationally benchmarked examinations taken by students worldwide.

At 7hills, we teach IGCSE in alignment with our school ethos, emphasising engaging lessons and project based learning. The curriculum integrates knowledge acquisition with the development of essential skills, including critical thinking, problem solving and real-world application. Our approach ensures that students are well-prepared for advanced studies by fostering a deep understanding of concepts.



A-levels Year 12 - 13

Studying A-levels at 7Hills provides students with the opportunity to deepen their academic knowledge while developing valuable skills in critical thinking, research, and problem-solving.

A-levels allow students to focus on subjects they are passionate about and take their expertise to the next level. The Pearson A-level curriculum is designed with an international perspective, ensuring that the content remains rigorous and relevant for learners worldwide.

Language Arts

In Language Arts, students explore the English language's meaning, purpose, and power. They develop critical thinking, literary analysis, and communication skills while expanding their vocabulary and improving both written and oral expression.

The 7Hills library is a welcoming space for reading and study, designed to inspire a love of learning. It offers a diverse collection of fiction and non-fiction books that reflect the school's international mindset. Students can borrow books for home learning or personal reading. Each student has a personal Kindle for use in class and at home, providing access to e-books, audiobooks, Google Classroom, and educational apps.

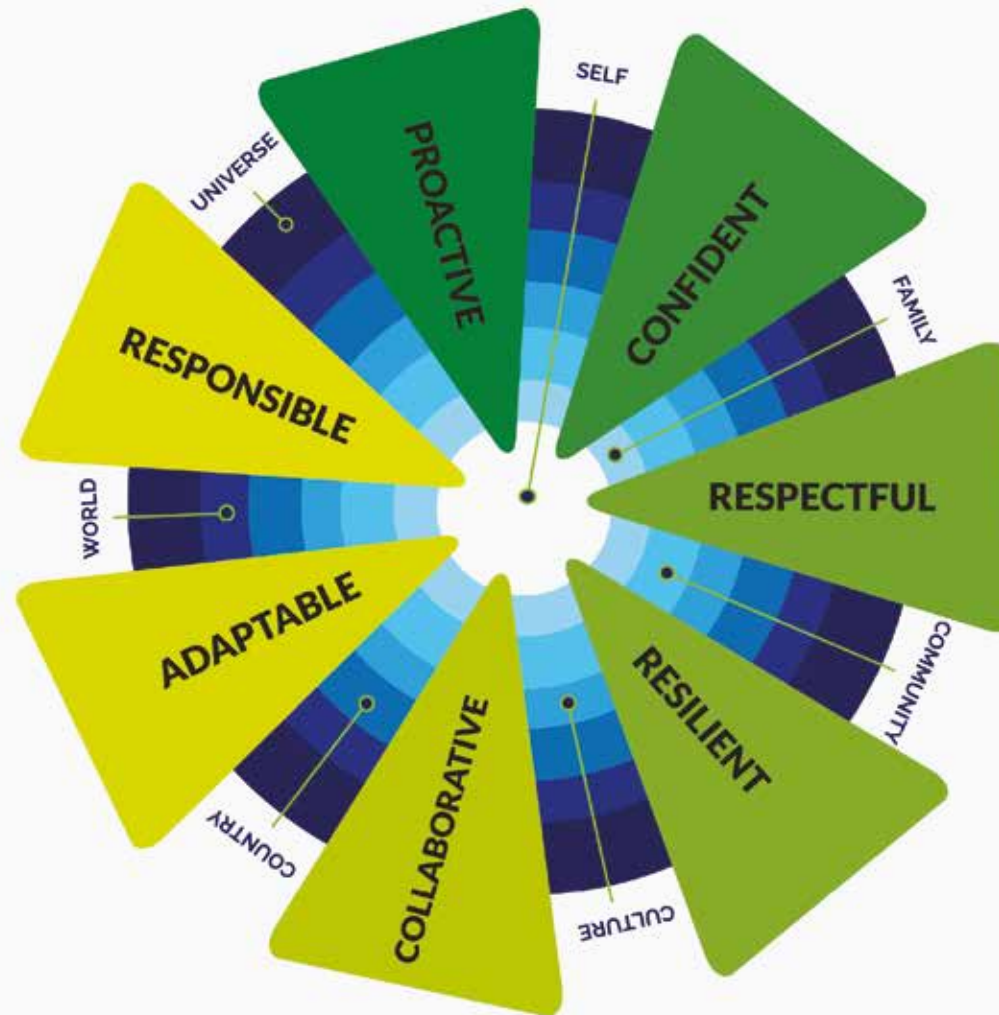


Modern Foreign Languages

Our foreign languages program offers compulsory French and Spanish in middle school (Year 7 to 9), equipping students to communicate beyond their mother tongue. Lessons emphasize cultural context, appropriate communication, and connections to various fields of study. Students compare linguistic structures in French, Spanish, and their own language, gaining skills that deepen their understanding of our globalized world. At the high school level (Year 10 to 13), students can choose to specialize in either French or Spanish, studying it in greater depth.

Mathematics

Learning math is an adventure into the unknown. The ideas that we adults take for granted are a wild, unexplored country to our children” – Denise Gaskins

In middle school, 7Hills follows the Singapore Maths Program, using Dimensions 6, 7, and 8 for Years 7, 8, and 9. This approach builds strong mathematical foundations while introducing new concepts to prepare students for advanced studies. Lessons are interactive and discovery-based, with hands-on activities that encourage exploration, broaden understanding, and highlight real-world applications of mathematics.

In Years 10 and 11, mathematics remains compulsory and follows the Pearson IGCSE syllabus, where students can choose between the Foundation and Higher tier exams. At A-Level, Mathematics is offered as an optional subject for those who wish to study it in greater depth.

Science

Our integrated Science course explores both the Natural and Physical Sciences, helping students understand the living and non-living world around them. Through Biology, Chemistry, and Physics, students investigate, expand their knowledge, and refine their scientific skills.

Life Sciences focus on the diversity, patterns, and relationships of living organisms, while Physical Sciences examine how Earth’s systems are governed by fundamental physical and chemical processes. Learning is inquiry-based, fostering critical thinking and problem-solving skills.

Students are encouraged to explore connections between scientific disciplines and develop an appreciation for scientific inquiry. Hands-on experiments and classroom activities provide opportunities to analyze information, collaborate effectively, and use technology to access and evaluate data.





ICT & Computing

Formal study of computer sciences equips students with essential ICT skills, preparing them for evolving global technologies and careers. They learn to work with industry-standard software and apply computing skills across disciplines. The curriculum covers key areas such as data management, digital content creation, and programming, with a strong emphasis on responsible Internet use, online etiquette, and digital safety.

We strive to integrate technology seamlessly throughout the school, with cloud-based tools like G-Suite for Education enabling collaborative learning both in class and at home. Additionally, all students have access to our Digital Library through school Kindles (Fire 7 tablets).

HUMANITIES

History

Our History course fosters perspective and an appreciation for diversity by connecting the past to the present. Students explore historical inquiry methods, examining how history is recorded, interpreted, and analyzed through primary sources. They study the cultural, political, social, and economic dynamics of past societies and their interactions, gaining insight into how historical events shape the world today. By understanding these influences, students develop a deeper awareness of how history continues to shape their own lives and global society.

Geography

Geography lessons invite students to explore big questions about the world and our place within it. As they study the physical environment and human behavior, they reflect on how natural processes and human activity shape the world in interconnected ways. They consider the impact of environmental issues, the organization of spaces, and the diverse activities that drive societies economic, social, political, and cultural. Through this exploration, students gain a deeper understanding of how geography affects their own lives and how people in different parts of the world influence each other. They also develop practical skills in using maps, atlases, and other tools to navigate and interpret the world around them.

Drama is an essential part of the International Middle Years Curriculum, offering students valuable life skills and fostering teamwork. Through drama, students build confidence, critical thinking, and creative expression, while learning to give and receive constructive feedback. They explore their voices, develop emotional expression, and refine both interpersonal and public speaking skills. By engaging in imaginative projects, students enhance their cognitive abilities, which complement their work in other subjects. The course also allows them to perform scripted plays, where they creatively use voice, movement, and facial expression, as well as design and incorporate scenery, props, costumes, and makeup to bring their performances to life.

In sports, our athletes consistently shine in the ISSAK league, while our debating team recently earned outstanding results at the World Scholars Cup.

The ISSAK sports league is a competitive inter-school league in which we participate in basketball, volleyball, track and field, football, and swimming against the seven largest international schools in Uganda. We won several ISSAK titles in various sports over the years.

Our students also thrive in STEM, competing nationally and representing Uganda at the International Science Olympiads. We're also proud of our annual Upcycled Plastic Boats Race on Lake Victoria, which raises awareness about pollution and encourages environmental responsibility. Some of our students have

proudly represented Uganda in international Science Olympiads.

Field Trips

At 7Hills, students explore the culture, history, and diversity of Uganda through carefully planned visits and expeditions to significant cultural, historical, and entertainment sites. Past destinations have included the Uganda Museum, the Baha'i Temple, the Gaddafi Mosque, and the Goodall Institute, where students met Dame Jane Goodall. They've also experienced Nile white-water rafting, the Art Biennale festival, walking tours of Kampala, rock climbing, and overnight trips to conservation areas. These experiences help students connect with Uganda's rich heritage while fostering a deeper understanding of its people and landscapes.

Week Without Walls

This is a unique experience where students step beyond the classroom to explore Uganda, engage in service, develop leadership and gain real-world skills through adventure, culture and teamwork.

7Hills Events

School Council Events: The school council organises an event each term that spans from Movie Night to Sports competitions.

School Events: Each term 7Hills Teachers puts on a school event that is open to the wider community. These have included a literary festival with well renowned Ugandan authors, art workshops and exhibitions by local artists, and a Science exhibition focusing on the environment.

Community Events: The parent representatives organise an event each term that is sometime only for parents/guardians and often open to the whole family inclusive younger and older siblings. These events are great to foster the community spirit.

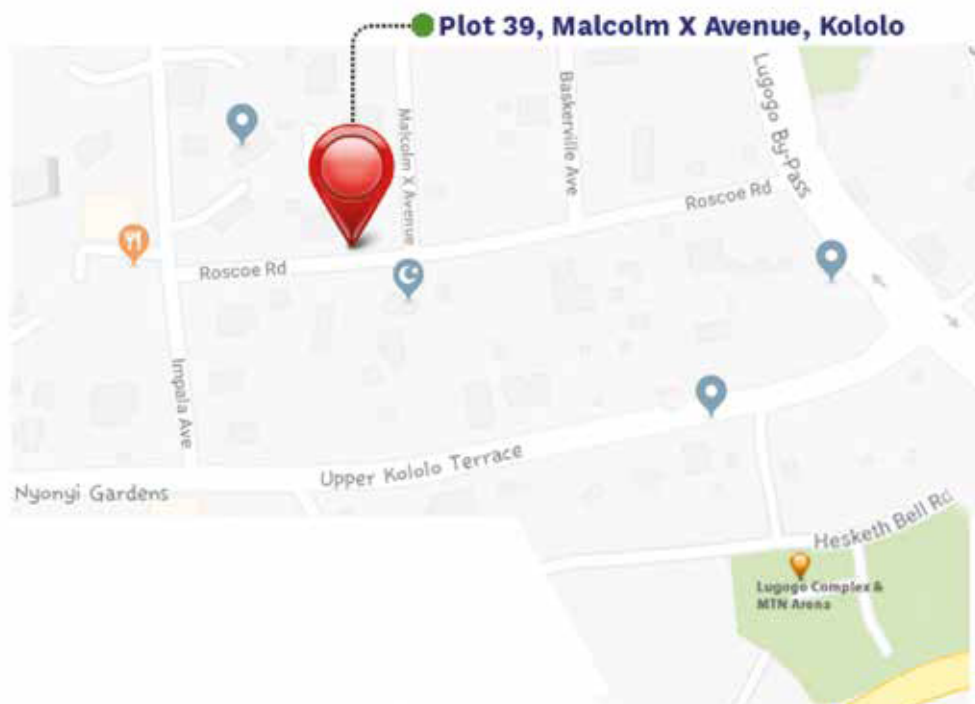

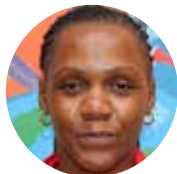
